Lisa earned her bachelor's degree in accounting at Baylor. She and her husband (also a Baylor graduate) have three children.

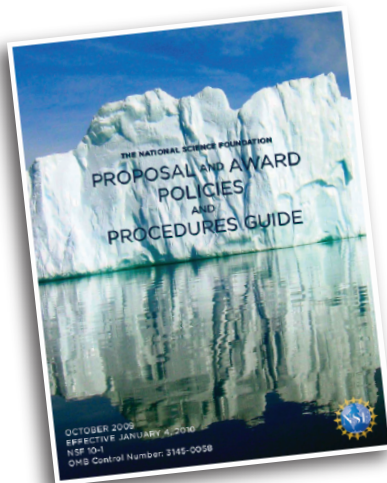

Community of Science (COS) has made a number of improvements to enhance the usefulness of its funding search tools.

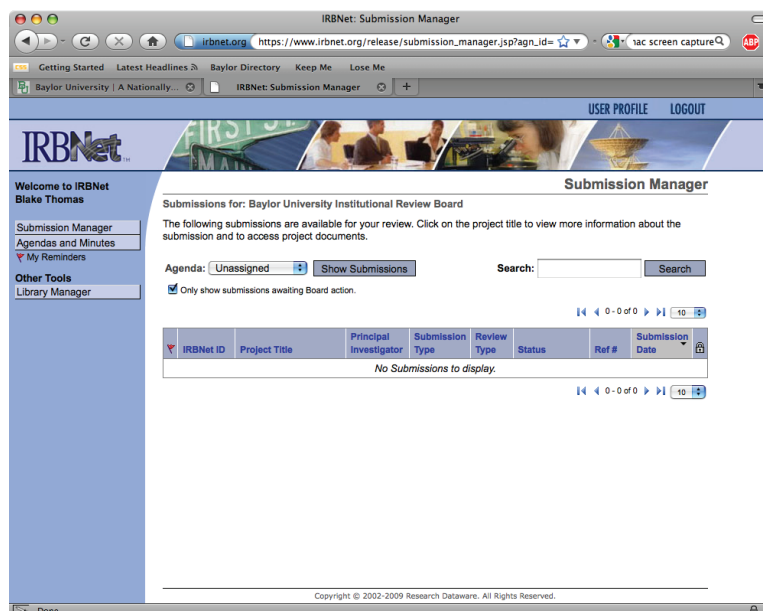
IRBNet Brings Streamlined Process for Submission, Tracking of Human-Subjects Protocols

Starting next month, Baylor's Institutional Review Board will be moving to a new system for management of research protocols. The new tool, IRBNet, provides an easy online method for investigators and IRB members to review and act on proposals.

Investigators will submit their research protocols to the committee through the IRBNet system, and the online toolset will help administrators and IRB members review and act on the proposals in a timely manner.

The new system is slated to roll out on November 24, 2009. Closer to the transition, further announcements will be made regarding sign-up and training procedures for investigators.
