

How to resize batches of pictures at once:

1. Open Fireworks
2. Click "File"
3. Select "Batch Process"
4. Select the folder where you saved your images, and select all of the images you want to resize and click "Add" if you want to resize all of your images.
5. Click Next
6. Under "Batch Option" select "Scale" and press "Add."
7. Select your scaling method:
 - a. No Scaling
 - b. Scale to Size (Which will stretch the image)
 - c. Scale to Fit Area (which will maintain the picture proportions)
 - d. Scale to Percentage (Preferred method - using pixel width of 200)**
8. Type your desired pixel size or percentage
9. Click Next
10. Under "Batch Output" click "Custom Location"
11. Choose folder where you want to save the resized images by highlighting the destination.
12. Click "Select"
13. Click "Batch"
14. The images will be resized automatically, click "ok" when the process is complete and the computer prompts you.
15. You are officially done and have earned the respect and admiration of your peers
