

## Prospective Religious Student Organizations

Prospective religious organizations applying for charter must submit the following documentation to the Department of Student Activities

## for review:

- An Application for Student Organization Charter
- A Constitution (signed by Advisor(s) and the President)
- A Roster
- A Statement of Faith (see below)
- A signed Affirmation of the Statement of Common Faith form (see next page)

## Statement of Faith\*

A statement of faith is a statement of the core beliefs of a religious group. A typical statement of faith is a summary of the core beliefs of a particular prospective religious student organization. Religious organizations without a formal affiliation with a particular church or church tradition will use a statement of faith for identification and definition. Although adherence to a statement of faith is not usually required for membership, it can serve as a normative statement for corporate worshippers within an organization.

Your organization's statement of faith should address items including, but not be limited to:

- Jesus Christ and the role of His resurrection
- The Trinity
- The role of the Bible
- Sin
- Redemption

Please ensure that your organization's statement of faith is a minimum of 100 words. Include your organization's statement of faith with the above listed documentation when submitted to the Department of Student Activities for consideration.

\*Please note that your organization's materials, including the statement of faith, will be reviewed by the Baylor University Spiritual Life Advisory Committee, the Department of Student Activities, the Dean for Student Development, the Vice President for Student Life and the President of the University.
