- 3. Budget and Budget Justification: Provide a single typed page indicating supplies required to complete the project. A justification should be given for each item in your budget. List source and amount if any funds are being requested from other sources.
- 4. Letter of Support: Provide a typed letter of support on Baylor letterhead paper from the faculty member supervising the project.
- 5. Unofficial transcript

A completed application must have all 5 of these documents listed above and will not be evaluated unless they are all provided.

General Information regarding the Folmar Grant

- 1. The Folmar Research Grant provides funds in support of RESEARCH and will not be awarded for (1)travel to scientific meetings or (2) cost of publication.
- 2. There are limited funds available. No student will receive more than \$1000. The amount awarded will depend on the amount of funds available and the number of quality proposals received. An itemized budget must be clear, concise, and justified so your request can be thoroughly evaluated.
- 3. Travel to research sites can be accomplished with Department of Biology vehicles, thus funds will not be awarded for travel to research sites.
- 4. No funds will be awarded to an individual or lab from which a project summary of prior support is not on file.
- 5. Funds awarded for this project must be expended by December 31, 2014.
