Bibliography of Texas, 1795-1845. 3 vol.

Ref Z 1339 S8

Books written and published in Texas and about Texas in the period before it was annexed as a state.

Footnotes to American History: A Bibliographical Sourcebook.

Ref Desk Z 1236 S48

Brief descriptions of historical events followed by suggested readings. Texas subjects are found in the index.

A Guide to the History of Texas.

Ref Z 1339 G84 1988

This lists archival collections in the state that contain primary documents about Texas history.

Texas Reference Sources: A Selective Guide.

Ref Desk Z 1339 T48x

A general annotated bibliography broken down into broad categories – humanities, social sciences, history, pure and applied sciences.

Library of Congress Subject Headings

Five large red volumes at reference desk which provide an alphabetical list of subject headings which are used in the online catalog.

This can also be accessed online at http://www.loc.gov. Select "Search our catalogs" from the menu and enter keywords for your subject. The resulting list will give you the subject headings used in the online catalog.

Provides names, phone numbers, addresses, etc. for people working in state agencies (including government officials).

The <u>Houston Post</u> is the only Texas newspaper with an index. You can use it like the <u>New York Times Index</u>.
