

Keston Citation Guide

The Keston Archive and Library contains the following types of resources:

- Books
- Samizdat and Vertical Files
- Digital Images
- Photos
- Manuscripts

Since there is no single perfect way to cite archival materials, the Keston Citation Guide is developed with an intention to provide guidelines for a researcher and hopefully to make his/her work easier in some way.

The following are recommendations for citing the Archive's resources by category:

Books

Books and articles should be cited in accordance with a style preferred by a researcher's department.

Samizdat and Vertical Files

The Keston Samizdat and Vertical files contain newspaper and journal clippings, newsletters, brochures and manuscripts.

These items must be described by author, title, publisher, date, and file name.
