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Profile of Non-Returning Provisional Admit Students Fall 2010 to Fall 2011

This profile contains descriptive information for provisionally admitted students enrolled in Fall 2010 who did not return for Fall 2011.

Forty-nine percent of the non-returning provisional admit students were female, while 24 (55.8%) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students in racial or ethnic minority groups retained at a lower rate than non-minority students: 46 of 70 (65.7%) minorities returned while 69 of 88 (78.4%) non-minorities returned. Ninety-five percent of those who did not return are U.S. citizens.

The mean SAT score for non-returning provisional admit students was 1041 compared to 1030 mean SAT score of the provisional admit students who did return. The mean ACT score was 22.6 for the provisional admit students who did not return compared to 21.3 mean ACT score of the provisional admit students who did return. Of the 43 provisionally admitted students who did not return in Fall 2011, four (9.3%) were on academic probation (but met provisional requirements) and 22 (51.2%) were suspended due to not meeting provisional requirements.

The following table contains trends of fall to fall retention rates for the past five years. The retention rates for first-time freshmen include provisional admits.
