

# Presentation Classroom Instructions – HSFAC 162D

HSFAC 162D is equipped with an iMac and a flat-screen TV.


## Television

1. If the instructor's iMac is turned off, press the power button on the back side of the iMac at your left.
2. Once the login screen appears, enter your BearID and password.
3. Turn on the TV by pressing the green POWER button on the Sony TV remote.
4. If no image is being displayed:
  - Check that the TV input is set to MAC by pressing the INPUT button on the TV remote, scrolling to MAC using the up/down arrow buttons, and selecting using the center button.



## Display Setup

- The iMac is set to use the TV as a secondary monitor.
- PowerPoint will display your presentation on the TV while showing Presenter View on the iMac.
- To display other programs on the TV, drag them to the top or left (whichever direction the second monitor is indicated; this setting can be also changed in the System Preferences, under Displays) of the iMac desktop and they will appear on the TV.
- To set the TV to show whatever appears on the iMac, click the Apple button in the top left and choose System Preferences. Select Displays and check the Mirror Displays check box under the Arrangement tab.



## Volume Controls

Use the VOLUME + / - button on the TV remote to control volume. A mute button is provided below the volume button.

## HDMI Input

- You may connect HDMI-equipped devices to the system using the HDMI input on the wall plate.
- To select the HDMI input, press the INPUT button on the TV remote and select the HDMI input using the up/down arrow buttons. Select that input by pressing the center button.

## To Shut Down:

1. Log off the iMac.
2. Turn off the TV.
