Enrollment is limited to 10 students who complete all application and preparation requirements and whose personal and professional goals match the BiB mission of "faith-based service learning" through health promotion (see *www.baylor.edw/soe/baylorinbrazil* for more info).

The following checklist includes steps required for application/acceptance into the program *and* for trip preparation if you are accepted and commit. You must also apply online.

The total BIB program fee is \$4400. After the \$500 deposit, you may pay the full amount owed by the Payment #1 deadline *or* follow all payment increments/deadlines described below. You must *also* pay Baylor through the usual channels for the required 6 credit hours of summer tuition and related fees. Note the scholarship information/opportunity under *step 1* below!

7	Deposit: Place your \$500* deposit check (payable to <i>Baylor in Brazil Program</i>) in a sealed envelope addressed to Dr. Eva Doyle. <i>See below for delivery/mailing instructions</i> *	
8	Interview: Complete a 30-minute interview with Dr. Eva Doyle by the designated deadline. (Email her at Eva_Doyle@baylor.edu to inform her that you have applied and to set up an interview.)	February 2-20, 2015
