#### (6) Range of Teaching Experience:

At Baylor University I have taught PHI 5350 Workshop in Teaching Philosophy, PHI 4360 Contemporary Ethical Theory, PHI 3301 Moral Philosophy, PHI 1308 Introductory Topics in Ethics, PHI 1306 Introduction to Logic, BIC 3358 Biblical Heritage, and the Baylor Honors College Colloquium.

As chair of the Georgetown College philosophy department I taught a variety of undergraduate courses, especially Ethics, Modern Philosophy (17th and 18th centuries), Economic Justice, and Philosophy of Religion. In 1985 I introduced the teaching of business ethics at Georgetown. I offered seminars on Virtue Ethics, Friendship and Love, C. S. Lewis, and Augustine, and guided honors research (three semesters of independent study) on Nagarjuna, Calvinist Economic Theory, and Descartes' Theology.

In 1997 I introduced tutorial courses to Georgetown College modeled on the teaching methods at Oxford University and Cambridge University. My tutorials were Human Nature (Nietzsche, Marx, Freud, and Edward Wilson are popular choices) and Theism and the Natural Sciences.

In Georgetown's graduate program in education I regularly taught Philosophy of Education and offered an innovative course on visual critical thinking called "Thinking in Pictures."

In 1983 I started The Thursday Group, an informal seminar for about thirty administration, staff, faculty, students, and townspeople. The group met weekly and discussed books such as Bellah, Habits of the Heart; Palmer, To Know as We Are Known; Brueggemann, The Prophetic Imagination; Weaver, In the Beginning God: Contemporary Science and the Christian Doctrine of Creation; The One-Act Plays of Horton Foote; Columbus' Egg: New Latin American Stories on the Conquest; Contemporary African Short Stories; Hillerman, Dance Hall of the Dead and Coyote Waits; Marsden, The Outrageous Idea of Christian Scholarship; The Gospels in Our Image: An Anthology of Twentieth-Century Poetry Based on Biblical Texts; Upholding Mystery: An Anthology of Contemporary Christian Poetry; The New Religious Humanists; and other recent titles.

In 1997 I organized Books and Culture, a discussion group for students who want to integrate their faith with their intellectual pursuits. About twelve students joined me each month to review articles in *Books and Culture*.

Through presentations on Shaker theology (Elderhostel), virtue ethics (Sunday Evening Seminars at Faith Baptist Church, Georgetown; Seventh and James Baptist Church, Waco), biblical studies (Immanuel Baptist Church, Lexington; Faith Baptist Church, Georgetown), and Christian ethics (Seventh and James Baptist Church, Waco; First Baptist Church, Calgary, AB) I have shared my professional and personal interests with wider audiences. Kentucky Humanities Council grants funded my course for Scott County teachers and a book discussion through the Scott County Public Library.

#### (7) Project Leadership Experience:

In 2000 I became the first director of The Center for Christian Ethics at Baylor University. The Center establishes creative partnerships with university ethics centers, church denominations, and programs at Baylor University. Its primary publication, *Christian Ethics: A Series in Faith and Ethics*, is published quarterly to provide Christian laypersons with thoughtful reflection and reliable guidance in engaging the ethical dimensions of today's world. The Center has sponsored a number of campus symposia. It sponsors the Baylor Medical Ethics Conference each year and cooperates in publishing and conference projects with other Baylor units. The Center's Web site, *www.ChristianEthics.ws*, is a major repository of articles, worship materials, and hymns produced by the Center. A parallel Web site in the Indonesian language offers teaching resources for Indonesian Christians.

Beginning in 1995 I led the Georgetown College's effort to develop a dual degree program with Regent's Park College, Oxford. I was scheduled to assume the directorship of the Oxford Program in Fall 2000. Undergraduate students may study humanities for one year or earn a dual degree in theology from Oxford. Georgetown faculty may develop research programs of Christian scholarship and ministers may take sabbaticals at Regent's Park College.

I directed Georgetown's participation in the Faith & Learning Project (sponsored by Lilly Endowment, Inc. and directed by Michael Beaty at Baylor University). I helped develop the Georgetown survey instrument to compare approaches to faith-learning integration by faculty at Baylor University, Notre Dame University, Samford University, Boston College, and Georgetown College. I proposed a faith-learning institute for students and faculty at Georgetown College who want to integrate an academic discipline(s) with their Christian faith. For several years 75 students enrolled in the pilot course, PHI 150 "Forming A Christian Mind".

I became chair of the Philosophy Department in 1993. That year, with Zahi Haddad (Business Department), I developed the Business and Ethics major. Since 1995 I have led three national searches for philosophy faculty members. Georgetown College developed a top philosophy department among liberal arts colleges.

In 1990-91 I co-authored (as a participant in the Lilly Faculty Development project) a comprehensive framework for faculty career development.

My interest in writing-across-the-curriculum began in 1983. That spring I wrote the successful faculty development proposal to the Lilly Endowment, Inc. on this topic. During the summer, with three colleagues, I developed the proposal at the Lilly Summer Seminar on Liberal Arts, at Colorado College. The next two years I chaired an *ad hoc* committee on writing-across-the-curriculum at Georgetown.
