Graduate assistant behavior therapy provider responsibilities include:

- (1) conducting thorough assessments of contingencies maintaining challenging behavior;
- (2) implementing behavior analytic treatments to reduce challenging behavior;
- (3) conducting thorough assessments of areas in need of instruction;
- (4) planning and implementing interventions to increase communication, academic, adaptive, and other related skills;
- (5) providing caregiver, practitioner, and volunteer consultation and support;
- (6) planning and implementing data collection procedures;
- (7) constructing data reports and sharing with caregivers and other support staff;
- (8) providing caregivers and other support staff with research-based intervention information;
- (9) participating in ongoing research projects;
