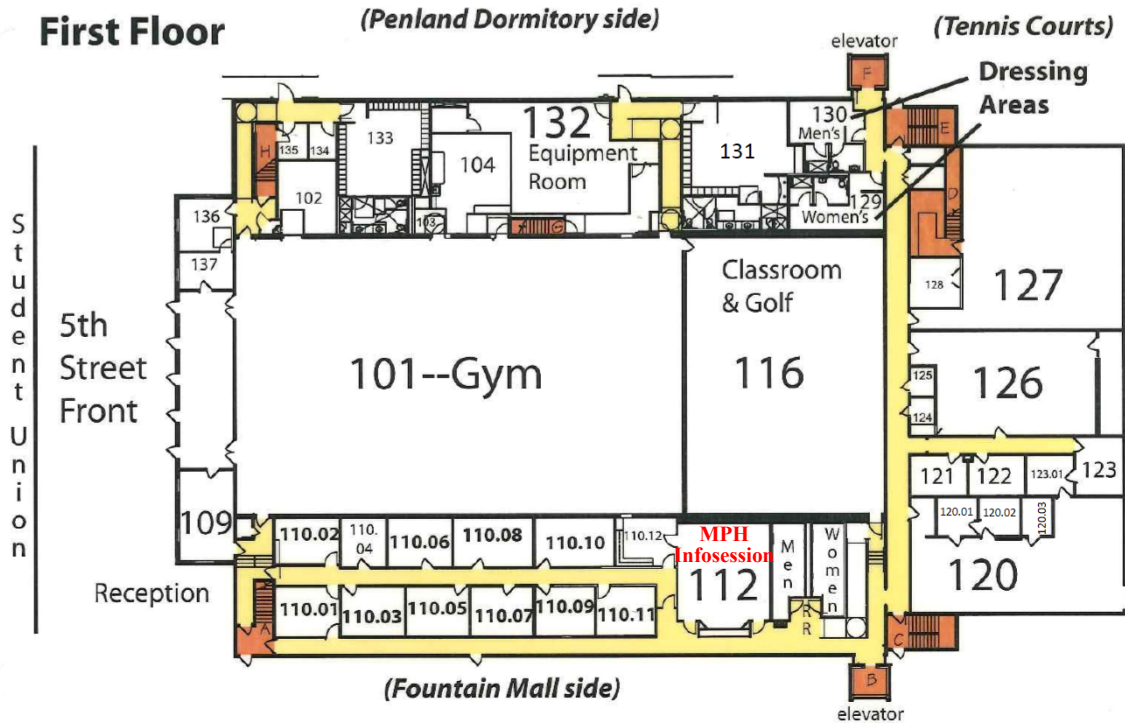

## **1- Parking Registration:**

If you make a 1-time visit within a 30-day period, you are considered an “infrequent visitor” and do not have to register your vehicle for a visitor’s parking permit.

## **2-Where to Park**

We recommend that you park in front of the Wiethorn Visitor’s Center (lot #52) because there are more visitor parking spaces there. 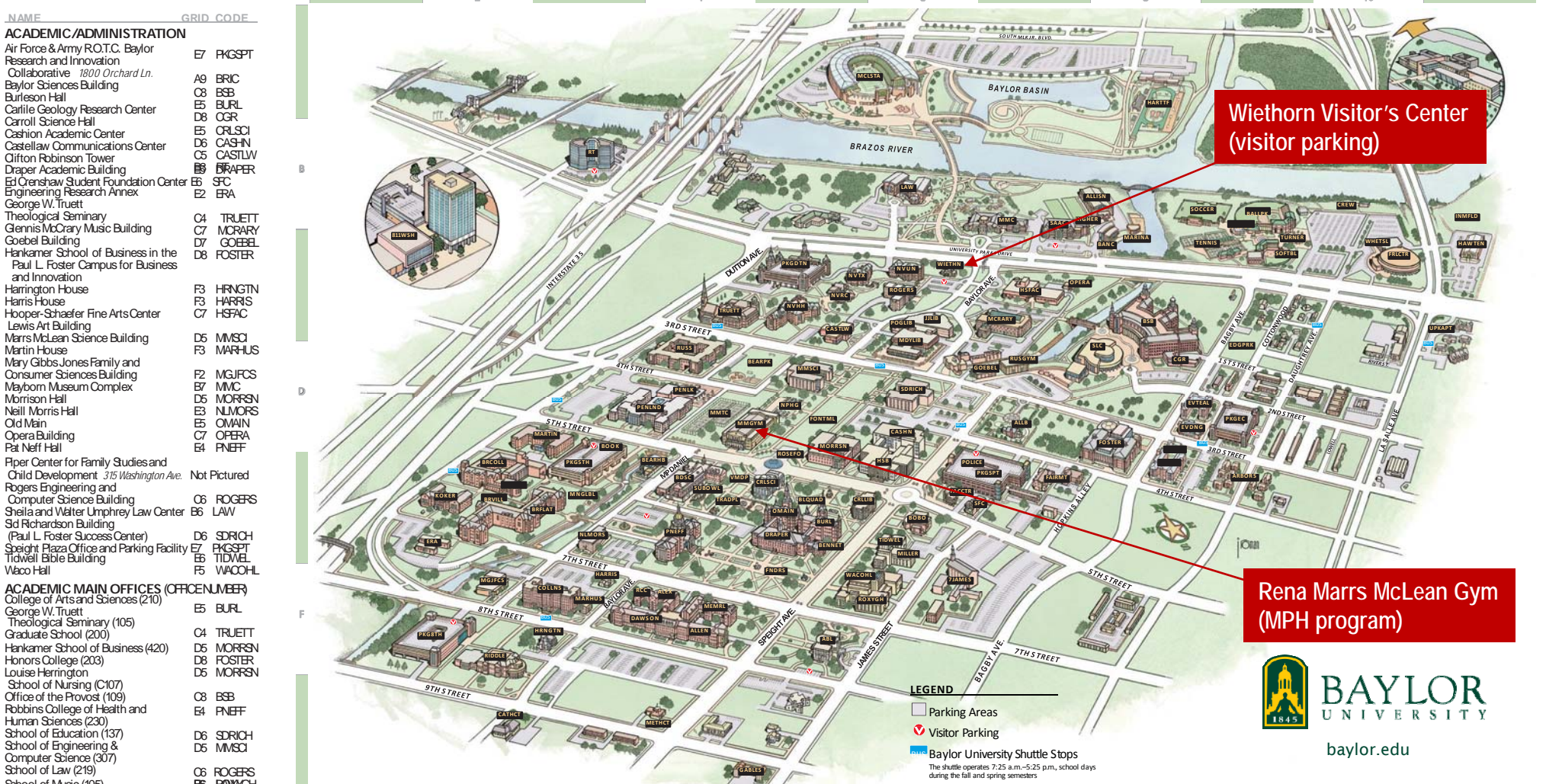
