STRING PROJECT RULES

- NEVER leave your instrument in the car! -

(The varnish and rosin could melt and run all over the instrument)

STUDENTS

- 1. Arrive between 4:00 and 4:15 (please do not arrive earlier).
- 2. Have your parents sign you in and out at the entrance to Waco Hall East.
- 3. Take your name tag with you at sign-in and keep it with you at all times.
- 4. Wait at sign-in until a teacher arrives to escort you to the classroom.
- 5. Take your place in the room and sit quietly when you arrive.
- 6. Raise your hand when you have a question.
- 7. Do not bring food or drinks into the building.
- 8. Never run with your instrument.
- 9. Do not take your bow out of the case until told to do so by a teacher.
- 10. If you need to go to the restroom during a session, notify the teacher first. The teacher will send you with your parent (if present) or request another teacher to escort you to and from the restroom.

PARENTS

- 1. Arrive between 4:00 and 4:15 (please do not arrive earlier).
- 2. Sign your child in and out at the entrance to Waco Hall East.
- 3. If you are staying to observe class, please sign in and take a parent name tag.
- 4. Pick-up time is 5:00pm.
- 5. Do not bring food or drinks into the building.
- 6. Please do not interrupt class with questions; save them for afterward.
- 7. Review homework assignments with your child.
- 8. Ask your child to demonstrate and discuss what they have learned.
- 9. If a child needs to go to the restroom during a session, the teacher will send them with their parent (if present) or request another teacher to escort the child to and from the restroom.
