Application Timeline

Applications to the ECS-LLC for new freshmen and transfer students have priority consideration based upon the date received. However, all spots could be filled before that date. If so, accepted applicants will be placed on a waiting list. The ECS-LLC is a competitive program and an early application does not guarantee admission.

- Early Action I status: application received by October 15; applicant notified by December 1.
- Early Action II status: application received by December 1; applicant notified by January 15.
- Regular Admission I: application received by February 1; applicant notified by March 15.
- Regular Admission II: application received after February 1; applicant notified within one month.

Every ECS-LLC resident is expected to:

- Meet all requirements necessary to remain in **good academic standing** within the School of Engineering and Computer Science (as stated in the Baylor University Undergraduate catalog).
- Enroll and complete one **ECS-LLC cohort class** each semester for freshmen (courses satisfy degree requirements).
- Participate in and contribute to **events** planned for ECS-LLC students (meals together, movie nights, guest speakers, etc.).
- Pay an LLC **fee** for programs and activities that specifically benefit LLC students (this fee is added to the semester room rate).
- Contribute to an **environment where learning can flourish**.

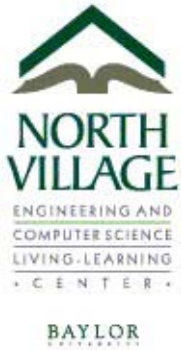
