

THE BAYLOR UNIVERSITY SUMMER MUSIC CAMPS
Middle School Band and Orchestra Camp
June 22-28, 2008
Grades 7-9

PURPOSE OF THE CAMP

The Baylor University Middle School Band and Orchestra Camp offers one week of fun-filled training in instrumental performance. The Baylor faculty and staff provide outstanding instruction through the course of the week. Participants experience the thrill of musical performance and take part in numerous recreational activities.

DAILY SCHEDULE

Each day, participants are involved in large ensemble rehearsals, sectional rehearsals, and group lessons. Group lessons teach musical skills and offer pedagogical techniques that allow students to strengthen performance skills.

HOUSING AND MEALS

Camp participants are housed in campus dormitory rooms that sleep two or three students. Roommate requests are taken in advance. All meals are served in university dining halls.

RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Daily recreational activities balance the musical and educational experiences of the camp. Each student will have the opportunity to enjoy supervised swimming, volleyball, basketball, and other games. Evening events include a trip to a local theater, the Cameron Park Zoo, and a visit to the Baylor Mayborn Museum. All trips are chaperoned carefully by the camp counseling staff.

ELIGIBILITY

The camp is open to all woodwind, brass, string, and percussion students who will enter grades 7-9 in the Fall of 2008.

CAMP FACULTY

The camp hosts some of the finest teachers in the state of Texas. Instrumental staff and ensemble conductors provide the highest quality of educational experience for students who participate in the camp.

COST

Residential tuition is \$485 and includes all meals, daily activities, and housing. Commuter tuition is \$325 and includes lunch and daily activities. Commuters may purchase breakfast and dinner for the week for an additional \$30. Students may purchase a CD recording and a camp t-shirt during the week or prior to the concluding concert on Saturday.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Camp enrollment is limited to 400 students and is filled on a first-come, first-served basis. The deadline for registration is May 30, 2008. Applications must be accompanied by a \$50 non-refundable deposit and completed medical and general release forms.
