- March 19** Deadline for **purchasing** doctoral regalia for May 2010 Commencement.
- March 22** Last day for submission of the Record of Oral Examination form to Graduate School for dissertation/thesis candidates for May 2010 Commencement
- March 30** Last day for electronic submission of the departmentally defended and approved copy of the dissertation/thesis to the Graduate School for May 2010 Commencement.
- April 2** Last day to satisfy the graduate foreign language requirement and report the results to the Graduate School. Refer to www.baylor.edu/MFL for details.

- April 23** Deadline for **renting** doctoral regalia for May 2010 Commencement
- April 30** Change-of-Grade form to remove incompletes and petitions for transfer of credit for all students and all coursework must be received by the Graduate School by this date.
- April 30** **Last day of classes.** Last day for non-thesis candidates to take the oral or comprehensive examination for May 2010 Commencement. The Record of Oral Exam form, or results from comprehensive exams, must be received in the Graduate School by this date (do not put in campus mail).
