



RefWorks Training Sessions Available in February

RefWorks is a Web-based tool (comparable to and compatible with EndNote) that can build a personal database of bibliographic citations by importing them from online library databases. Citations can be collected from databases or added manually, organized in folders, cited in papers and automatically formatted for bibliography and footnotes for specific styles (MLA, APA, Chicago, etc.). The citations can also be searched within your personal RefWorks database.

Attend one of the following seminars to learn more about RefWorks, including: how to set up a RefWorks account, import references from library databases, create your own records, create folders, use the citations in research papers and learn about an additional feature of RefWorks – RefShare.

Come to a session in Jones Library, Room 105, that fits your schedule.
