**HRS. REQUIRED:** 30 s.h. transfer required:  
30 s.h. of advanced level transfer work to be transferred from Washington University.

**NOTE:** A grade of "C" or better is required

in each course transferred from the professional school.

**The student will be held responsible for:**

1. Filing a graduation card, new mailing address, and name of professional school with the College of Arts and Sciences prior to leaving Baylor.
2. Completing a minimum of 97 semester hours prior to Entry into the professional school, with a minimum of 60 semester hours including the last 30 semester hours completed in residence at Baylor.
3. **Making sure that an official transcript for the correct number of transfer hours is available at Baylor by graduation deadlines.** (NOTE: Graduation may be delayed until Baylor can evaluate and accept the official transcript submitted by the student.)
4. Submitting a letter from the professional school verifying eligibility for honors from the professional school if the student hopes to be considered for graduation with **Honors on his bachelor's degree from Baylor.**
5. Note: Please inform the Office of Academic Scholarships and Financial Aid that you are enrolled in a Cooperative Program and that your senior year of study will be conducted at Washington University so that all awards granted by BU are expended while at BU. It is the student's responsibility to apply for financial aid at Washington University, for study there.
