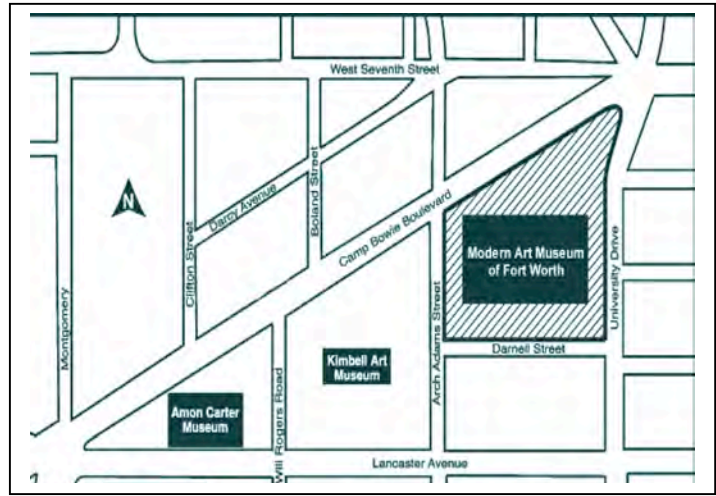

### SPECIAL EXHIBITIONS

#### Amon Carter Museum of American Art

- *The Art of Twentieth-Century American Illustrators* (May 28–December 18, 2005)  
This installation pairs works from the Carter's extensive collection of twentieth-century illustrated books with prints by the same artists-illustrators c.1920-40 from the museum's collection of works on paper.
- *Nineteenth-Century Texana* (July 16–December 8, 2005)  
Twenty-plus historic maps from the Amon Carter Museum library and archive chart the period of exploration and settlement.
- *Into the Night* [photographs] (August 13, 2005–February 5, 2006)  
Landscapes, portraits and abstractions explore the beauty and mysteries layered within nocturnal images.
- *The Spirit of 291* (August 13, 2005–February 5, 2006)  
Celebrates centennial of the founding of Alfred Stieglitz's Little Galleries of the Photo-Secession with a small exhibition of works offering a unique opportunity to experience the flavor of the legendary gallery that became known simply as 291.
- *Avedon at Work: Photographs by Laura Wilson* (September 10, 2005–January 8, 2006)  
(photographs made during the summers of 1979–1984 when she assisted Richard Avedon on *In the American West*)
- *In the American West: Photographs by Richard Avedon* (September 17, 2005–January 8, 2006)  
Exhibition commemorating Carter Museum's commissioned project (1979-84), 78 of the 124 original photographs.

#### Kimbell Art Museum – *between exhibitions/see highlights of permanent collection:*

Caravaggio, Bernini, Rembrandt, Boucher, David, Friedrich, Turner, Monet, Caillebotte, Cézanne, Munch, Picasso, Braque, Mondrian

#### MAMFW:

*Anselm Kiefer: Heaven and Earth* (September 25, 2005–January 8, 2006)  
This exhibition is the first American survey of the artist's work in almost twenty years (first one was at MoMA), includes more than sixty paintings, books, and sculptures created between 1969 and the present. Its goal is to reveal the layers of meaning threaded throughout all of Kiefer's work, specifically focusing on his career long meditation on the relationship between heaven and earth.
