Fall 2008

The seminary enrollment of 406 includes 281 males and 125 females. There are 367 masters students and 38 doctoral students. Twenty-three percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 94 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 376 United States citizens, 4 resident aliens, and 26 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 14 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 23 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.2.

Fall 2007

The seminary enrollment of 402 includes 283 males and 119 females. There are 365 masters students and 36 doctoral students. Twenty-one percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 93 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 374 United States citizens, 3 resident aliens, and 25 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 15 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 20 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.3.
