Fall 2008

The graduate enrollment of 1,369 includes 13 students classified as Graduate Nondegree. There are 528 new graduate students. Forty-seven percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and 27 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty-one percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Eighty-six percent of these students are United States citizens, while 198 (15%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 47 foreign countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 1050 -1300 with a mean of 1172 for the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and 540 - 640 with a mean of 585 for the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).

Fall 2007

The graduate enrollment of 1,291 includes 9 students classified as Graduate Nondegree. There are 459 new graduate students. Forty-eight percent of the graduate enrollment are males, and 27 percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Thirty percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

Eighty-four percent of these students are United States citizens, while 208 (16%) are resident or nonresident aliens, representing 50 foreign countries. The score range for the middle fifty percent of graduate students is 1040 -1290 with a mean of 1170 for the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and 540 - 620 with a mean of 577 for the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).
