Once it has been determined that a student can no longer remain in an activity class, the instructor is responsible for informing the student of viable options. The viability of options will depend on the time at which the student was injured in the semester. If the student chooses to transfer to HP 1104, the following will apply.

- According to university policy, absences accrue even though the person is injured or ill.
- Absences in the HP activity class will carry over to HP 1104.
- HP 1104 is scheduled at 1:25 MWF and will end at 2:15. In order to be enrolled in the class, the student must attend the class at this time. There are no other class sections. The student may not “work out” on his/her own and get course credit for the HP 1104.

In order to receive credit for HP 1104, the student needs to complete the following.

1. The injured student is responsible for dropping the HP activity course and adding HP 1104. If the student does not drop and add, problems with course credit arise at the end of the semester.
2. Within two days of the notification, the student is to contact Dr. Margaret Woody, Coordinator of HP 1104. At this point, the student will make an appointment to discuss the student’s participation in HP 1104.
3. When the student meets with Dr. Woody, the student needs to bring with him/her a request for HP 1104 from the attending physician. Faxes are accepted.
4. With that request, the student needs to bring the physician’s or physical therapist’s recommended rehabilitation program. The responsibility of the instructor is to administer this program.

After both the instructor and the injured student have read the information listed above, each should sign in the appropriate blanks below. The HP activity instructor should complete the form and return it to Dr. Woody.
