Baylor University Named the 2008 President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll!

Baylor University has been named to the 2008 President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll! The Honor Roll was established in 2006 to recognize colleges and universities nationwide that support innovative and effective community service and service-learning programs. The Honor Roll, a program of the Corporation for National and Community Service, is sponsored by the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation and the U.S. Departments of Education and Housing and Urban Development. The Honor Roll recognized Baylor for having excellent community service programs, including Steppin' Out, Santa's Workshop, Baylor Buddies, Baylor Relay for Life, and Baylor Habitat for Humanity through the Department of Student Activities, University Missions through the Department of Spiritual Life, and several GEAR UP programs (Physics Circus, Math Initiatives, LEAF, and Marsh Madness). In 2008, we estimate that students volunteered 114,444 hours through these programs and other community service projects.

Women Needed for a Resveratrol and Pterostilbene Supplementation and Exercise Study.

Researchers in the Center for Exercise, Nutrition, and Preventive Health Research at Baylor University are recruiting 36 inactive, overweight women between the ages of 18 to 35 to participate in a study designed to evaluate the effects of resveratrol (found in grape juice) and pterostilbene (found in blueberries) supplementation and exercise on insulin sensitivity. Participants will be asked to take a supplement or a placebo for seven days, donate blood samples, and donate muscle biopsies. Eligible participants will receive \$100 for completion, along with free body composition testing and may have the opportunity to be enrolled in a two-month exercise and nutrition study.
