Summer Costs

Tuition for six hours will be **\$4,752**. Other costs for one summer session include:

Required Fees **\$432.00**

Room in a residence hall **\$749.00**

Board **\$532.59**

Applying for summer aid

- **File the 2008-2009 FAFSA to be considered for financial aid for the 2009 summer semester**
- **The 2009-2010 FAFSA is required to be considered for financial aid for the 2009 Fall and 2010 Spring semesters**
- **If you are admitted for the summer and want to be considered for financial aid you need to complete both the 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 FAFSAs.**



Applying for summer aid

- www.fafsa.ed.gov
- We may request additional documents, including verification. Do not send us documents unless specifically requested by our office.
- Once we have all the necessary documents, we will process your financial aid and begin the summer aid process



Types of Summer Aid

- **Federal Pell Grant** – awarded to students with high need based on their FAFSA results. **Note: we do not anticipate having SEOG funding for the summer.**
- **Federal Stafford Loans** – awarded to all students who complete the FAFSA and any additional documents requested by our office.
- **Federal Work Study** – awarded to students who demonstrate need on their FAFSA results. **Remember summer requires more intensive academic study.**
- **Alternative loans**

- **Remember to also complete the 2009-2010 FAFSA**
- **After we receive and process your FAFSA, you may contact our office if you have questions with award details, costs, terms to know, and the payment process.**



Aid for Future years

- **We post additional scholarship opportunities on our website every year. Be sure to keep checking!**
- **We also have a departmental scholarship search engine on our website**
- **You can apply for a merit scholarship if you earn a Baylor Cumulative GPA of 3.5 and have earned 60 hours. It will take a CGPA of 3.0 to renew the following year**
- **We also offer denominational scholarships for our Baptist students. You can find these scholarships on our website under Baptist Scholarships**
