

BAYLOR PARKING REGULATIONS 2009-2010

Revised September 2009

Parking regulations are established by Baylor University so that the University's business can be conducted in a safe and orderly manner and to provide parking as conveniently as possible within the limits of space available. Although a few key regulations are listed below, **it is the student's responsibility to know and follow all Baylor parking regulations.** Regulations are fully explained on the Baylor website at: www.baylor.edu/parking

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. When on Baylor's campus, all vehicles, including visitors, are required to have a valid Baylor Parking Services issued parking decal be it a permanent or temporary decal.
2. Students must park in designated Student lots unless otherwise indicated by signage.
3. Not knowing the regulations or not seeing a sign is not a proper excuse for a dismissal or an appeal.
4. Be aware there are 24-hour Reserved F/E parking spaces around Moody Library.
5. Always park in a space marked with two yellow lines. If you do not park within yellow lines, you may be ticketed for parking "In a Driveway" or "Not a Designated Space."
6. A valid Baylor parking decal and approved Handicap decal are required to park in disabled and timed parking areas.
7. Disabled, Hall Director, Maintenance, Loading Zone and other specifically designated areas are reserved 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
8. During the last week of school, finals, dead week, Diadeloso, rush, etc., regulations are enforced.
9. IMMEDIATELY affix your parking decal in the proper area on your vehicle window. Parking decals are non-transferable. See decal placement examples on the web. If the decal is lost or stolen, the owner is responsible for filing a report and obtaining a replacement decal at a published reduced fee.
10. A \$25 fine will be charged to your account if you register the wrong license number for your vehicle.
11. Replacement for a non-transferable decal will be issued for a fee of \$10 per replacement decal when identifiable remnants of the decal are provided.
12. Authorization to park anywhere other than your designated areas may be granted only by Parking Services.
13. Vehicles parked on the grass will be towed at the owners expense.
