- Student must actively participate in all departmental play productions.

- Theatre majors may substitute THEA 2298 & 2299 for one semester each of Human Performance.
- English requirement: Students are allowed to take either ENG 1304 or FAS 1118, 1128, and 1138. Students majoring in the sciences may take ENG 3300 instead of ENG 1304.
- A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses used for the major.
