*Please print and bring these instructions with you on Move-In day!*

**All traffic, unloading of personal items, and parking will be directed on move-in day due to heavy congestion and significant parking limitations.** The following directions and information are provided to assist as you proceed through the check-in process on move-in day. Additional signs and event personnel will be in place to provide assistance as needed. Please note, this process is *different* than previous years, so we appreciate your attention and cooperation.

**From Hwy 6, going north/east (from Houston area):** Merge onto TX-434 SPUR North which will become US-77, follow the sign that says Baylor University (Left Exit). Turn right on University Parks, left on Bagby St. and right on 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Follow the instructions to the unloading areas for Kokernot Hall.

**From I-35, going south (from Dallas area):** Exit at the University Parks off-ramp, turn left onto University Parks Drive, turn right on Bagby St. and then right on 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Follow the instructions to the unloading areas for Kokernot Hall.

**From I-35, going north (from San Antonio/Austin area):** Exit at the University Parks off-ramp, turn right onto University Parks Drive, turn right on Bagby St. and then right on 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Follow the instructions to the unloading areas for Kokernot Hall.

**There is no parking at Kokernot. After unloading, Kokernot residents will be asked to park in the Speight Street garage or Ferrell Center parking lot and walk or catch the trolley back.**

**What to Do Before You Pack and Leave:**

- Please adhere to the following information and your assigned check-in time frame.
- Try to avoid bringing large unloading vehicles such as rental trucks, trailers, etc. as parking for these special vehicles is extremely limited and not present in the surrounding area.
- Try to consolidate all items to be unloaded in one vehicle to reduce the amount of cars in the unloading zones.
- **All items must be labeled with the student's name, hall and room number, and if fragile.**
- Avoid packing boxes that weigh more than 50 pounds, bring a dolly cart if possible to assist with your heavy boxes because elevator access is extremely limited.
- Please dress comfortably as the weather will be very warm.
- Remember to bring your Baylor Student ID card if previously issued.

**What to Expect When You Arrive to Unload:**

- Once you arrive to the unloading zone, the student resident will check-in with a staff member at the unloading zone and then proceed to their room. If other family or friends are present, they will be asked to assist in the unloading process and then park the vehicle in designated parking as soon as it is unloaded to avoid congestion in the check-in process.
- Awesome faculty, staff, students and community church volunteers will **assist you** in the unloading process!
- Once your vehicle is unloaded, you will be directed to move your car immediately to a parking facility.
