The Board of Regents of Baylor University invites expressions of interest in, and nominations for, the position of University President.

Baylor University in Waco, Texas, is a private Christian university and a nationally ranked liberal arts institution. The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching classifies Baylor as a research university with "high research activity." The mission of Baylor University is to educate men and women for worldwide leadership and service by integrating academic excellence and Christian commitment within a caring community.

Chartered in 1845 by the Republic of Texas, Baylor is the oldest continually operating institution of higher learning in Texas and the largest Baptist university in the world. Baylor University's Baptist founders sought to establish an institution of higher learning dedicated to Christian principles, superior academics and a shared sense of community. Though 80 percent of its 14,500 students call Texas home, Baylor enrolls a diverse student population representing all 50 states and 80 countries. The University is located on a beautiful 735-acre campus in Waco, Texas, a community with a population of 229,000, 80 miles south of Dallas and 100 miles north of Austin.

The University offers 146 degree programs at the undergraduate level, 76 master's programs, 25 doctoral programs, and the juris doctor degree through its 11 schools and colleges. The University's annual budget is approximately \$450 million and the endowment is currently valued at approximately \$1 billion.

The 14th President of Baylor will be the Chief Executive Officer of the University, will report to the Board of Regents, and will be expected to articulate and exemplify the mission, foundational assumptions, and core convictions of Baylor University which can be found at www.baylor.edu/about/vision/.
