Profile of Seminary Students Fall 2008 and Fall 2009

This report contains descriptive information about students enrolled in the Seminary as their primary or secondary program in Fall 2008 and Fall 2009. If a student is in a dual program or dual career (MDiv/MSW, PhD/MTS, etc.), the student is counted in <u>each</u> program (i.e., program count).

Fall 2009

The program count of 399 includes 259 males and 140 females. There are 364 masters students and 35 doctoral students. Twenty-five percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 94 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 370 United States citizens, 7 resident aliens, and 22 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 14 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 23 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.3.

Fall 2008

The program count of 407 includes 282 males and 125 females. There are 368 masters students and 38 doctoral students. Twenty-four percent are from racial or ethnic minority groups and 94 percent are affiliated with the Baptist denomination.

The seminary student body is comprised of 376 United States citizens, 4 resident aliens, and 27 nonresident aliens. The foreign students represent 14 foreign countries.

Part-time students make up 23 percent of the seminary student body. The average credit hour load for seminary students is 9.2.
