### **Who is Your Academic Advisor?**

Your specific advising areas are listed for you. Log into BearWeb at [www.baylor.edu/bearweb](http://www.baylor.edu/bearweb) > Student Services and Financial Aid > Advisement > Advisement Contact Information, to verify that your major is listed correctly, determine if advising is required, and find your assigned advisor(s). Also, verify that your "educational goal" is correct – premed or any pre-healthcare field, prelaw, etc.

### **Verify Your Major**

It is very important that your major is correct so that your assigned advisor(s) will also be correct. If you need to update your major, visit [www.baylor.edu/advising](http://www.baylor.edu/advising) > Academic Goals > Changing Majors/Minor/Program, and follow the change of major procedures. Any time you make a change to your major, minor and/or program refer to BearWeb again to find your new advisement contact information.
