**Position:** Tenure-Track Associate/Full Professor of Higher Education

**Qualifications:** Candidates must possess an earned doctorate in higher education or a related field, a strong record of published scholarship, demonstrated excellence in teaching undergraduate and graduate students, and the ability to work collaboratively to implement the vision of the department, the School of Education, and Baylor University. Experience working in higher education doctoral programs is required.

**Responsibilities:** We seek a distinguished faculty member in higher education who will teach in the existing masters program and provide leadership in the development of a doctoral program that will bring national visibility and scholarly prominence to Baylor in the field of higher education.

The faculty member will engage in productive scholarship, excellent teaching, and enthusiastic service in the university, the community, and the profession. He or she must participate collaboratively in creating and implementing a vision for the proposed doctoral program in higher education, enhancing the existing masters program in higher education and student affairs, and proposing an undergraduate minor in leadership. Position begins no later than August 2010.

**Rank and Salary:** Salary and rank will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.
