Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the conference being held?

The conference will be held on the campus of Baylor University, which is immediately east of Interstate 35 in Waco (exit 335B). With the exceptions of meals, the evening talks on Friday and Saturday, and the vespers service on Saturday, all events will be held at the Bill Daniel Student Center, which is located at the corner of South 5th Street and MP Daniel Esplanade (1311 S. 5th St., Waco, TX 76798; [building 25 on the campus map](#)).

Jean Bethke Elshtain's and George Marsden's evening presentations will be in the Banquet Room on the fifth floor of the Cashion Academic Center at the Hankamer School of Business ([building 47 on the campus map](#)).

The vespers service on Saturday, October 10 at 5:15 p.m. will be in the Foyer of Meditation at the Armstrong Browning Library ([building 15 on the campus map](#)).

Where do I check in?

Check in at the registration table located in the second floor foyer of the Bill Daniel Student Center ([building 25 on the campus map](#)). The table will be staffed from 1:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Friday, and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.

If you are arriving between 5:30 and 7:30 on Friday evening, then please report to the fifth floor of the Cashion Academic Center.

Where will meals be served?

Lunch and dinner on Friday and Saturday for registered participants will be served in the Banquet Room on the fifth floor of the Cashion Academic Center at the Hankamer School of Business ([building 47 on the campus map](#)).

Where can I park my car?

Visitor parking is available at the following locations:

- The parking lot south of the Bill Daniel Student Center ([building 25 on the campus map](#)), which is where most of the conference's events are being held;
- The parking lot north of the Cashion Academic Center ([building 47 on the campus map](#)), which is where meals and evening presentations will be held on Friday and Saturday;
- The Speight Plaza Office and Parking Facility ([building 50 on the campus map](#)) east of the Cashion Academic Center.

Please park only in those areas at these locations designated as visitor parking.

I indicated that I will be using PowerPoint on my confirmation form; what should I bring?

If you already notified us that you will be employing an electronic presentation during your talk, then we will have a projector in your room. Please bring your presentation on a data CD or Windows XP-compatible USB drive in a file format that is compatible with Microsoft PowerPoint 2007.

When/where is my presentation?

How much time do I have for my presentation?

All concurrent sessions are 90 minutes long, and most have three presenters. Please consult the schedule to confirm how many presenters are in your session and observe the following time allowances:

- Sessions with 2 presenters—presentations may be up to 30 minutes long;
- Sessions with 3 presenters—presentations may be up to 20 minutes long;
- Sessions with 4 presenters—presentations may be up to 15 minutes long.

The balance of the 90 minutes is set aside for discussion.
