

Summer 2015 Honor Code Violations Report

During the summer 2015 semester, there were 7 reported violations of the Honor Code. 2 of these cases proceeded to Honor Council hearings. The other 5 cases were handled by faculty. Some cases are still pending.

HONOR COUNCIL CASES:

Alleged Violation: Altered or falsified a university document.

Date of Violation: 3/19/2015

Decision: Guilty

Sanction: Received a Permanent "F" for the course. "F" will remain in the GPA. Required to write a Reflection Journal meeting approval of OAI Director and Honor Council Chair, and must meet with Associate Dean of Student Conduct Administration before December.

Alleged Violation: Obtained unauthorized information during an exam.

Date of Violation: 5/8/2015

Decision: Pending

Sanction:
