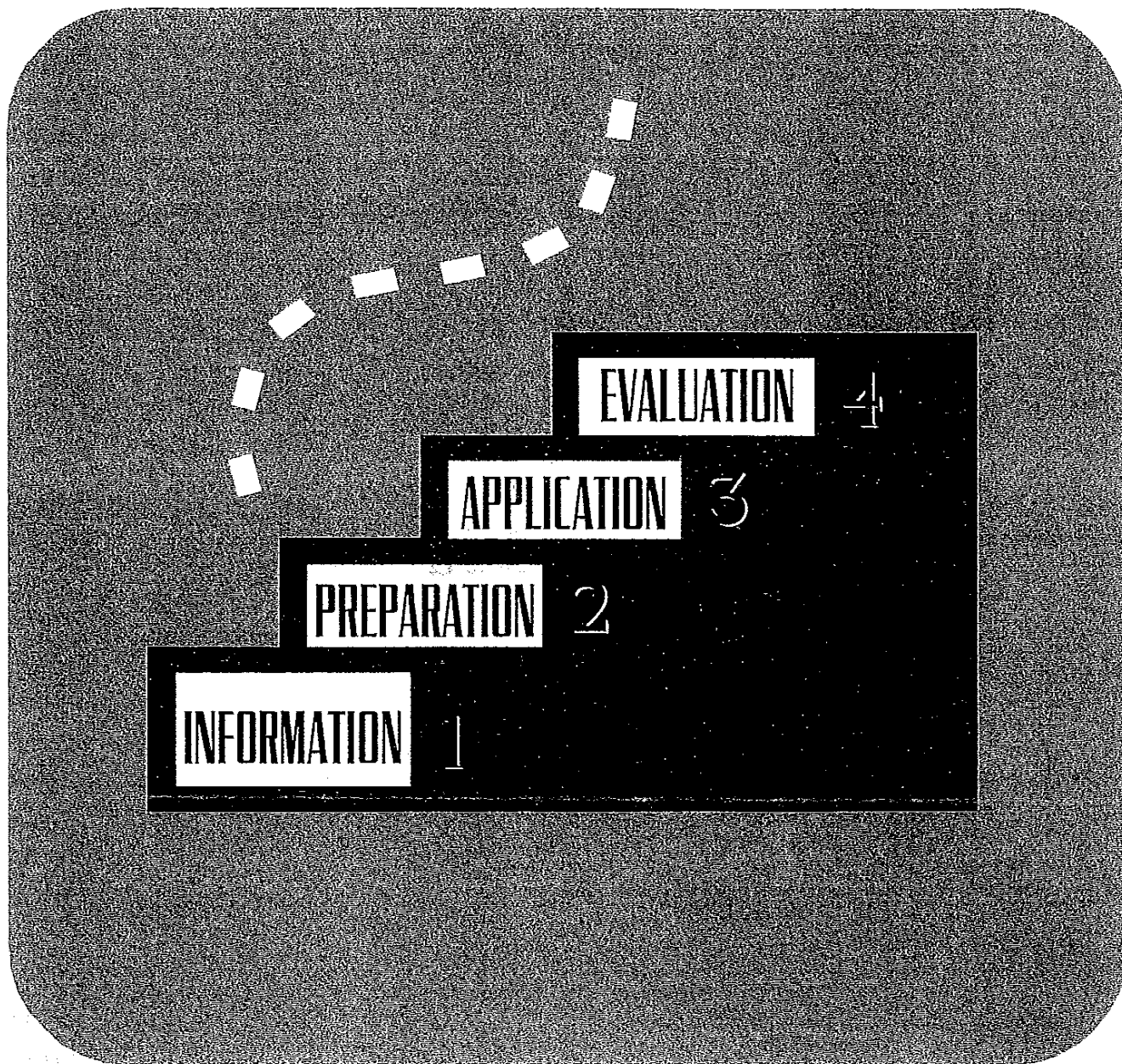
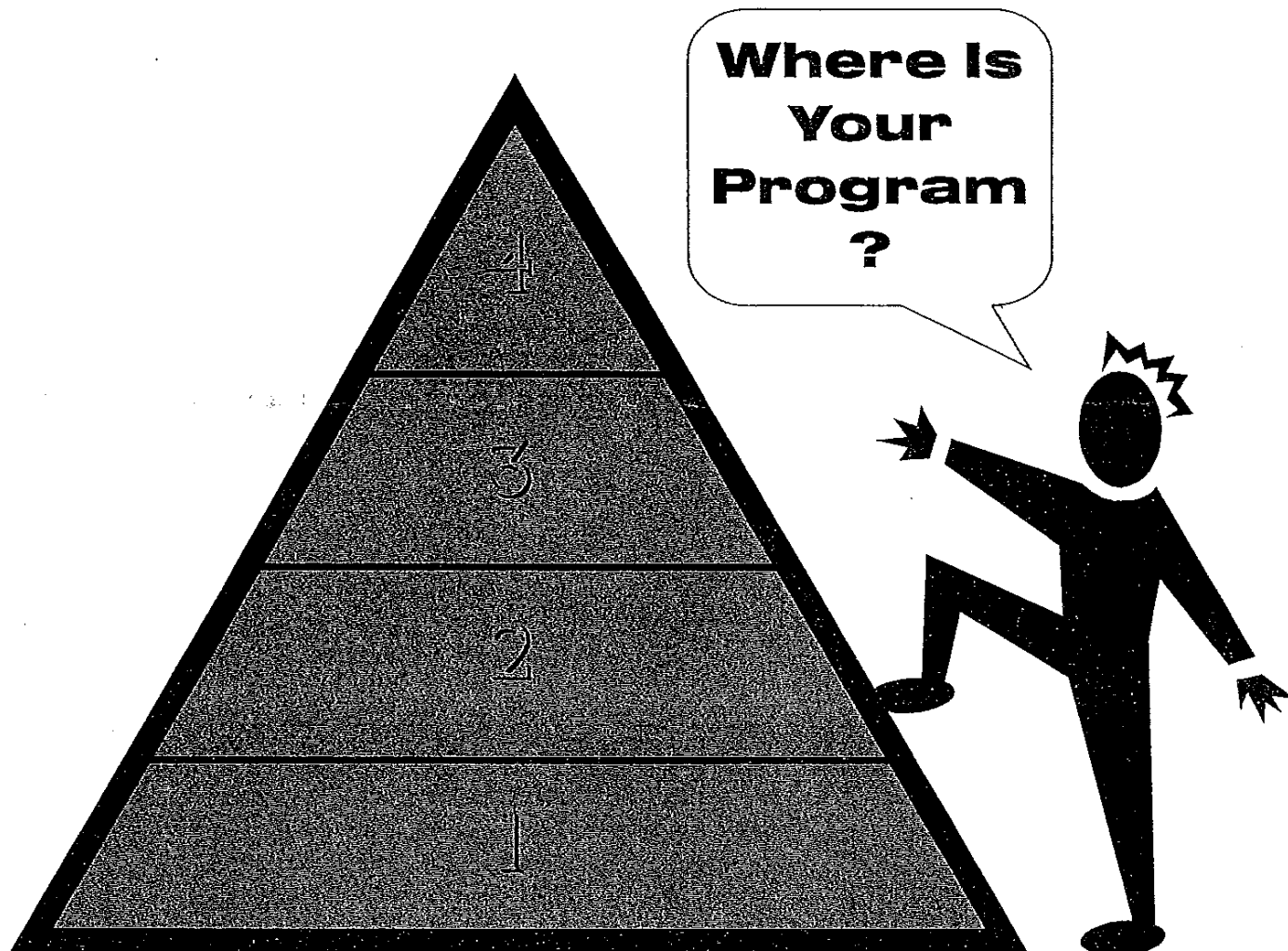

Four Steps...

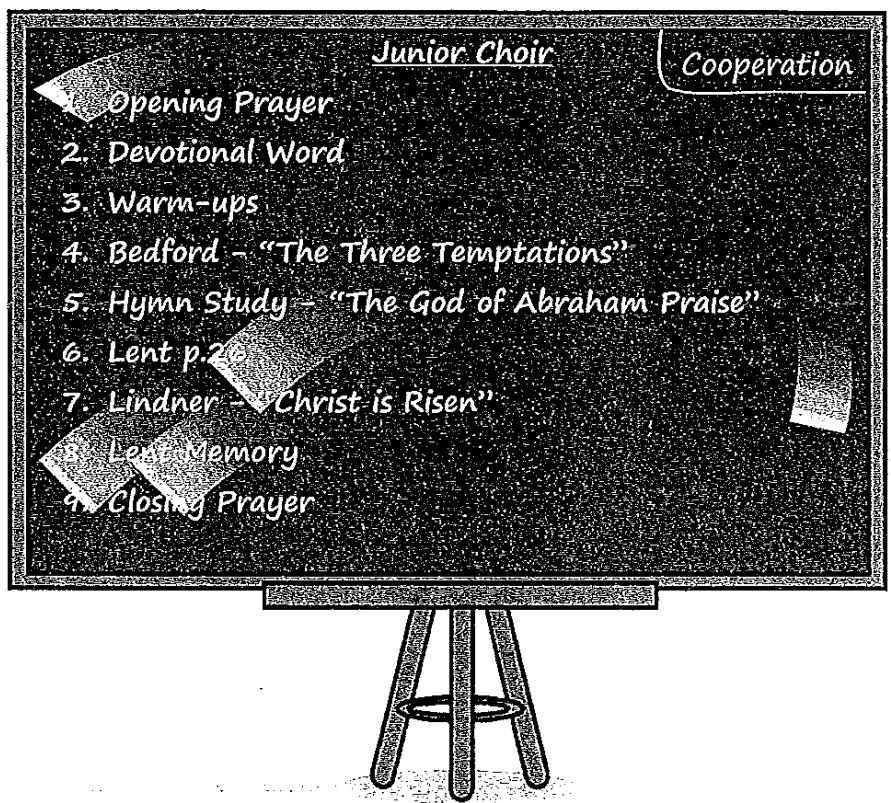


...Toward Better Rehearsals

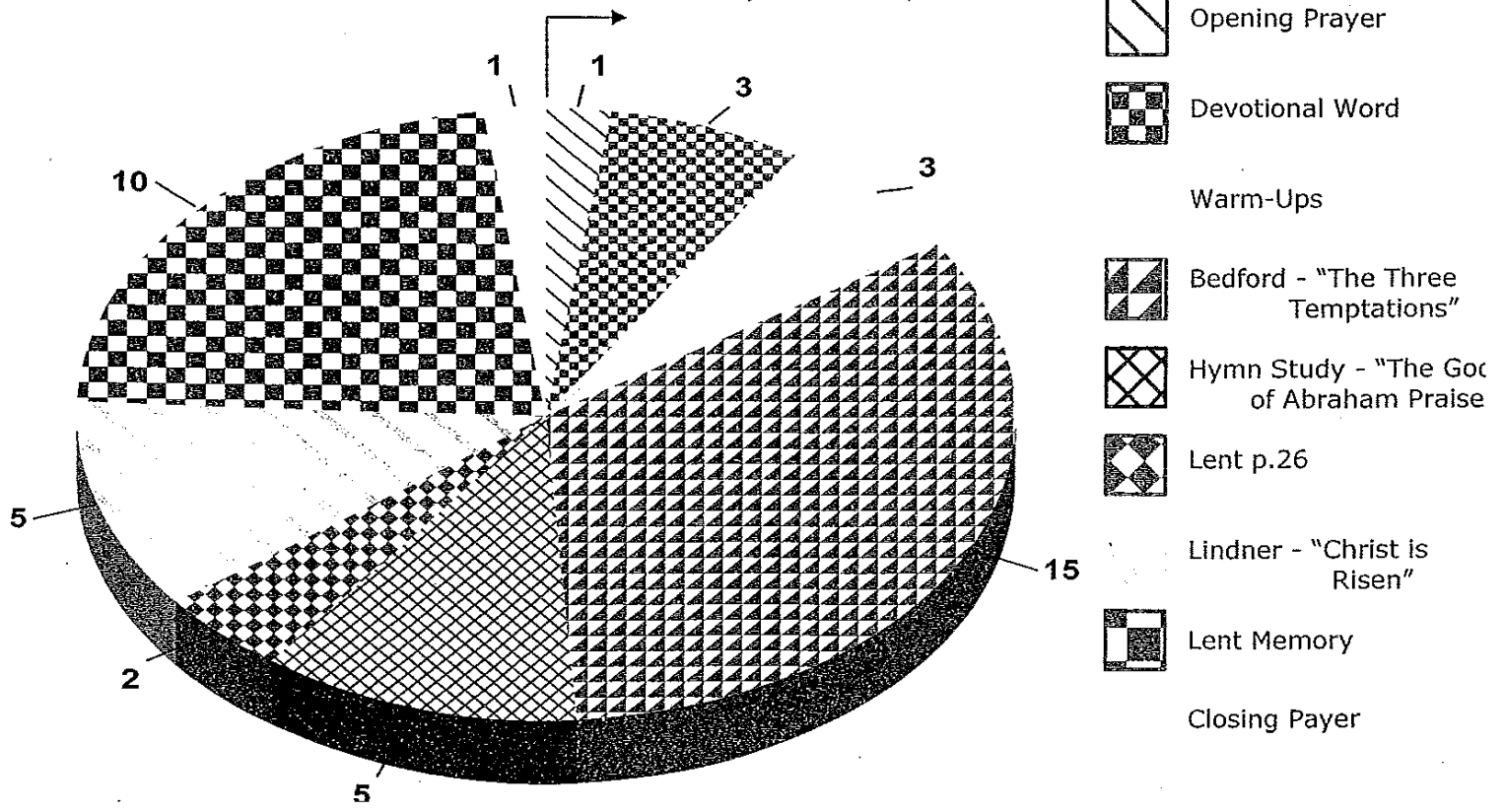


1. You spend countless hours recruiting and are all but paying children to be in your choir.
