Corporate Communication Courses: Students must choose 18 hours from the following courses: CSS 1305, 3304, 3306, 3311, 3312, 3314, 4301, 4302, 4303, 4304, 4305, 4306, 4311, 4312, 4313, 4314, 4315, 4336, 4380.

Rhetoric and Public Discourse Courses: Students must choose 6 hours from the following courses: CSS 2264, 2265, 3247, 3248, 3305, 3307, 3316, 3393, 3395, 4310, 4336, 4350, 4351, 4352, 4353, 4354, 4380, 4394, 4395, 4396, 4397, \*BIC 1323, \*BIC 1413. Note that the BIC Rhetoric courses cover this requirement, but students are encouraged to take other Rhetoric courses within CSS.
