All students must graduate with a minimum of 124 hours, 36 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level.

Notes about major requirements:

- Pre-Film and Digital Media - Students interested in Film and Digital Media as a major will choose the Pre-Film and Digital Media designation upon enrollment at Baylor. Application to entry to the Film and Digital Media major must be made to the Department after has completed FDM 1304 and 2360 with a grade of "B" or better. Students may repeat each of these introductory courses only once if they fail to make a "B" or better on the first attempt. Students may remain in the Pre-Film and Digital Media designation up until the completion of 60 hours. Students must change degree programs if unable to meet admission standards into the department upon their completion of 60 hours.
 - FDM 1303 is not a specific requirement. It would fulfill a requirement for one FDM course, but students could fulfill those requirements from a different upper-level FDM course.
 - FDM 2360 - students are encouraged to take this course as soon as possible because it is a prerequisite to many upper-level courses.
 - FDM 3361 is not a specific requirement, but it is a pre-requisite for many FDM classes and especially important if you are emphasizing the production track.
 - # If you plan on doing an internship in the fall of your senior year, take BIC 4374 Cultures V in your junior year.
 - Check your degree audit often through Bearweb to ensure that you are making timely progress toward your degree.
