All students must graduate with a minimum of 124 hours, 36 of which must be at the 3000/4000 level.

Notes about major requirements:

- PHI 1306 or 1307 or 4345 may be taken to fulfill the logic portion of the Philosophy Core. BIC Pre-Law students should take PHI 1306.
- A minimum of 15 hours total of upper level courses are required for the major.
- **Students completing World Cultures I, II, III, and IV in the Baylor Interdisciplinary Core may petition to receive 6 hours of lower-level credit toward the Philosophy major.
- Philosophy Concentration: Choose one sequence: Sequence 1: a) 6 semester hrs of 4000 level PHI courses other than 4345; b) 12 semester hrs of any level electives. Sequence 2: Pre-Law Concentration: a) 9 semester hrs from the following: PHI 3318, 4318, 4360, 4361, 4385; b) 9 semester hrs. of any level electives. Additional courses in logic recommended. Sequence 3: Philosophy and Medicine a) 9 semester hrs from the following: 1309, 4300, 4325, 4310; b) 9 semester hrs of any level electives. Sequence 4: Depart. Honors: a) 9 semester hrs of 4000 level Philosophy courses; b) 9 semester hrs of any level electives; see recommendations below; c) Requirements in other areas: Admission to the Honors Program and completion of upper-division Honors Program requirements; see Honors Program Handbook or the Honors Program section of the catalog for specific
- Philosophy Electives: In any sequence, a maximum of 3 hrs from the following list in other fields may be taken to fulfill elective requirements: ANT 4305; ECO 4338, 4343; FRE 4338; GER 4305, 4306; GKC 4301; HIS 4338, 4339, 4395, 4396; MTH 4326; PSC 3363, 3373, 4383; PSY 2402, 4327, 4329, 4339; REL 4346, 4353, 4354, 4390, 4393, 4395; SOC 4309, 4391; CSI 1340, 1430.
- A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses used for the major.
- Check your degree audit often through Bearweb to ensure that you are making timely progress toward your degree.
