- Theatre Performance Concentration: Complete One Sequence:

Sequence 1: (12 semester hrs) a. Six semester hours of advanced Theatre electives from 3103, 3014, 3113, 3114, 3297, 3298, 3303, 3304, 4103, 4104, 4113, 4114, 4297, 4298, 4301, 4335, 4365, 4366, 4395, 4VC5, 4V99. b. Complete six semester hours of 3000-4000 level Theatre Electives. 2) Musical Theatre concentration (12 hrs) to include THEA 3297; Ten hours from 3103, 3104, 3113, 3114, 4103, 4104, 4113, 4114, 3298, 4297, 4298. For this option, students must be admitted by faculty jury.
