**Notes about major requirements:**

**Child Development Electives:** CFS 3324 Children & Families Spec Needs (fall only); CFS 3357 Preschool Child; CFS 3358 Infant & Toddler Development; CFS 4363 Adolescent Development (12 hrs).

**Child Life Electives:** CFS 3357 The Preschool Child, CFS 3358 Infant and Toddler Development, CFS 3362 Child Life Theory and Practice (fall only), CFS 4363 Adolescent Development (12 hrs)

\* CFLE: courses required for certification as Family Life Educator. Must also take CFS 3354, 4191, 4356, 4357, 4365, 4367, CSS 4313 (or CSS 3311) and PUBH 4321 (adds 4 hrs to total credits).

**CFS Upper Level Electives:** any 3000-4000 level CFS course (6 hrs). Take CFS 4365 for CFLE.

**Professional Electives:** CLA 3381, CSS 3311, CSS 4313, EDP 3324, EDP 3330; PUBH 3320; PUBH 3325; PUBH 4321\* ; LS 3305; LS 4320; One of following PUBH 4327, SOC 4310; SOC 3311; SOC 3360; SOC 4329; SWO 4316; TED 3380; FCS 4V93; BIO 2401; additional 3000-4000 level CFS courses (9 hours). Take CFS 4356, 4357, 4367; CSS 4313 (or CSS 3311); and PUBH 4321 for CFLE. A grade of C or better must be earned in Professional Electives.

- A grade of "C" or better in all family and consumer sciences courses (ADM, CFS, FFCS, ID & NUTR) used for the major and a "C" average in courses taken outside the department.
