RLS 4V94 Internship in Leisure Studies. It is the student's responsibility to contact Dale Connally at least 1 year in advance of the internship semester to arrange for an approved internship. If the agreed upon internship is less than 9 hours, additional electives may be required.

***Recreation Ministry Restricted Elective:** One of the following religion courses can be taken if it was not selected in the junior year: REL 3301, REL 4396, REL 4398. If REL 3301 is selected, may substitute for BIC 3358 instead of BIC 4374/4389 above.
