Notes about major requirements:

Students need to complete the minor in ASL/English Interpreting in addition to the courses above.

– In order to enroll in the internship field experience courses (CSD 4660, 4661, 4662, 4663), candidates must have successfully completed CSD 4360 and 4361, have prior approval from the program committee AND meet the following criteria: 1) GPA 2.8 overall; 2) GPA 3.0 in the major; 3) Completion of required course work; 4) Must achieve passing score on the ASL Language Proficiency Exam.

– A grade of C or better is required in CSD 1406 in order to enroll in CSD 2301.

Scientific Method 2: Complete 3-4 hours from Scientific Method 1 or take one from CSI 2300; GEO 1306, 1307, 1309; HP 2306, 2307, 4368, 4369; NUTR 2351, 3314; PHY 3305; PSY 1305; RLS 4392; STA 2300
