Notes about major requirements:

Students must earn a "B" or better in the following four courses before they can take other CSD courses: CSD 1308, CSD 2318, CSD 2351, CSD 3357

Minimum 3.0 GPA average in the CSD courses required for retention in the major

– Students planning a career in audiology and speech pathology are encouraged to pursue a master's degree. Upon completion of the master's degree in communication sciences and disorders, students are eligible to seek certification by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and to seek licensure as speech pathologists.

* ASHA Required Courses

** Students must take BIO (BIO 1401 strongly recommended) and either PHY or CHE (PHY 1407 recommended, but student can also chose PHY 1405, CHE 1405, CHE 1300/1100. These will be petitioned to replace NW I and II. See BIC advisor for petition.

Foreign Language & Cultures Requirement: Students must complete a foreign language through the second semester level.

- Please keep in mind that this is only a suggested sequence. Actual sequence will vary according to possible second major, minor, other program of study (including pre-health), and individual circumstances (ex., transfer credit, dual credit, and credit by exam).
- In order to complete your degree, you must fulfill all requirements in your major and general requirements for the Robbins Bachelor of Science.
- To complete a double major, you may not count any courses toward both majors.
