Advanced Business Electives: Any 3000-4000 course in MKT, MGT, FIN, ENT, MIS, or BUS except BUS 3315. May be used to complete the Bus Adm minor or Entrepreneurship minor in the School of Business. May also request to substitute courses from another approved minor once the minor is complete (12 hrs required).

ADM elective: ADM 4132 & 4232 (odd summer study abroad) or ADM 3V90 or any FCS 4V93 Independent Studies Course approved by FCS Dept. or ADM 3354/4314 if it is not meeting another major requirement. 3 credit hours are required.
