



Apparel Merchandising Minor

Eighteen semester hours including the following:

- A. ADM 1300 Fashion Theory and Consumer Behavior OR ADM 2371 Apparel Quality Analysis
ADM 1391 Introduction to the Apparel Industry
ADM 2310 Textile Science
Prerequisites: CHE 1300 and CHE 1100, or CHE 1405

B. Nine semester hours from:

ADM 3364 History of Dress

Prerequisites: A minimum grade of C in ADM 1241, 2310, and 2311.

ADM 3365 Global Dress and Culture

Pre-requisite: ADM 1241

Note: Students can either take ADM 3364 or ADM 3365. They cannot receive credit for both.

ADM 3391 Apparel Financial Control

Prerequisites: MIS 1305 with a minimum grade of C and ACC 2301 or 2303

ADM 3393 Visual Merchandising and Promotion

Prerequisite: ADM 1241

ADM 3396 International Fashion Forecasting

Prerequisites: Successful completion of one of the following: ADM 1241, ADM 1300, OR ADM 1391.

ADM 4312 Textile Testing and Analysis

Prerequisites: A minimum grade of C in ADM 2310 and either CHE 1405 or CHE 1300 and 1100

ADM 4393 Case Studies in Apparel and Retailing

Prerequisites: A minimum grade of C in ADM 3391 and senior standing or approval of instructor

ADM 4132 Apparel Industry Field Study AND ADM 4232 Apparel Industry Field Study

Prerequisite for both: Three semester hours of clothing or textiles

- C. A grade of “C” or better in Family and Consumer Sciences courses (ADM, CFS, FCS, ID, or NUTR) used for the minor.
