Prerequisite: Upper-Level Standing
  - RLS 3382 Risk Management in HHRP  
Prerequisite: Junior level standing
  - RLS 4301 Outdoor Recreation  
Prerequisite: Upper –level standing
  - RLS 4391 Leisure Service Management
  - RLS 4393 Facilities and Equipment in HHRP  
Prerequisite: Upper –level standing
  - RLS 4396 Leisure Services for Persons with Disabilities  
Prerequisite: Upper-level Standing
- E. A grade of “C” or better is required in each course applied to this minor

*REL 3339, 3340, 3348, 3396, 4348, 4360, 4396, and 4398 will not be accepted for credit toward this minor. In addition to the eighteen hours listed above, the student must fulfill the six hour University requirement in Religion by taking REL 1310 and 1350.*
