\* Indicates the course is offered only that semester.

\*\* These courses must be taken in the semester shown and in noted order. It is critical to take the classes when noted. Each \*\*course is prerequisite to the next \*\* course and offered only in the semester shown except for 1311.

**Courses in the Apparel Design and Product Development major are highly sequenced and must be followed according to the MAP.**

A grade of "C" or better in family and consumer sciences courses (ADM, CFS, FCS, ID, or NUTR) used for the major.

ART: Select two classes from ART 1310, 1314, 2310, 2334, 2336, 2350, 3314, 3315 or 3316. Please note that 2310 and 2350 have prerequisites that would require you to take an additional ART course. Prerequisites for other courses may be petitioned by ADPD majors to be waived through the Art Department.

Transfer students who transfer a lower level class in place of an upper level course will need to take additional upper level courses to meet the requirement for 36 hours of upper level courses.
