### **Eighteen semester hours including the following:**

- A. REL 2480 Introduction to Ministry OR  
Prerequisite(s): REL 1310, 1350, and sophomore standing or above  
REL 3381 Communication in Ministry  
Prerequisite(s): REL 1310 and 1350; and upper-level standing
- B. Six hours of “3000” - “4000” level Religion courses - one upper level course from each of two of the three following areas in Religion:  
Area 1. Biblical  
Area 2. Historical  
Area 3. Theological
- C. RLS 3302 Program Planning in Leisure Services  
Prerequisite: RLS major or upper-level standing  
RLS 4395 Principles of Church Recreation
- D. Three hours from:  
RLS 2388 Leisure and Lifestyle Well-Being  
RLS 2389 Leadership and Facilitation in Leisure Services  
RLS 3301 Theory and Practice of Outdoor Adventure Programs  
Prerequisite: RLS major or upper-level standing  
RLS 3382 Risk Management in HHPR  
Prerequisite: Junior level standing  
RLS 4301 Outdoor Education  
Prerequisite: RLS major or upper –level standing  
RLS 4391 Leisure Service Management  
RLS 4393 Facilities and Equipment in HHPR  
Prerequisite: Upper-level standing  
RLS 4396 Considerations for Diverse Populations in Leisure Programming  
Prerequisite: RLS major or upper-level standing
- E. A grade of “C” or better is required in each course applied to this minor and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher for all REL and RLS courses

*REL 3339, 3340, 3348, 3396, 4348, 4360, 4396, and 4398 will not be accepted for credit toward this minor. In addition to the eighteen hours listed above, the student must fulfill the six hour University requirement in Religion by taking REL 1310 and 1350.*
