A grade of "C" or better in family and consumer sciences courses (ADM, CFS, FCS, ID, or NUTR) used for the major and a "C" average in courses taken outside the department.

Communication & Media Literacy: Select one class from: CSS 1301, 1302, 1304, CFS 3354, FDM 1303, 4340, JOU 1303, 3387, 4305, 4380

Electives (any level): 21-23 hours

FCS Upper Level Electives: Any 3000-4000 ADM, CFS, ID, NUTR or FCS course - **15 hours**

Professional Electives: These electives must be upper level classes that help meet the 36 hour advanced credit university requirement. These hours may be any 3000 or 4000 level class or they can be additional advanced FCS Dept. (ADM, CFS, FCS, ID, or NUTR) classes - **9 hours**
