To ensure that quality theological education remains affordable, **Truett awards a 50% scholarship to all Master of Divinity and Master of Arts in Christian Ministry students**, totaling over \$45,000 per student over the course of his or her time in seminary.

The **Truett Seminary Scholarship** is limited to 87 attempted hours of course work for the MDiv degree and 60 attempted hours of course work for the MACM degree. The University reserves the right to change tuition, fees, scholarships, requirements and regulations without notice.

The full-time course load of 10 hours is used for the above examples; however, student course load is typically 9-12 hours.

ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL FEES INCLUDE:

Books and supplies: \$500 per semester (estimated)

Vehicle permit: \$360 per year

BAPTIST STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

In addition to the Truett Seminary Scholarship awarded to all students, Baptist students may receive an additional award thanks to the generosity of the Baptist General Convention of Texas (BGCT). With the completion of the BGCT First Year Certification Form, MDiv students are awarded \$150 per credit hour and MACM and MTS students are awarded \$100 per credit hour. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

All Truett students may apply for federal financial assistance, which is comprised primarily of student loans. In order to be considered for federal aid, please complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

All federal aid applicants are encouraged to file the FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1, 2020, using the 2019 income information. Completing your financial aid file and the admission process by March 1 will enable Baylor University to notify you of your financial aid eligibility before your fall bill is due.

You can complete the FAFSA online at **fafsa.gov**. Complete the FAFSA using the information from your actual tax return from the 2019 year. Baylor's school code is **003545**.
