The Truett Baptist Scholarship is limited to 93 attempted hours of course work for the MDiv degree. Baptist students and students in the MDiv joint degree programs may be eligible to receive tuition scholarship beyond 93 attempted hours. The Truett Baptist Scholarship is limited to 60 attempted hours of course work for the MACM degree. Baptist couples attending Truett Seminary may be eligible to receive additional scholarship. BAPTIST CHURCH MATCHING GIFT PROGRAM

Baylor University will match on a dollar-for-dollar basis, not to exceed \$1,000 in an academic year, scholarship funds given to Baptist students from a Baptist church, state Baptist convention or Baptist-affiliated program. Duly authorized Baptist church leaders must certify a statement for each check in order to request matching funds. This statement is located at baylor.edu/sfs. Checks and statements must be received by the Cashier's Office in order for matching funds to be applied.

Matching funds are available for fall and spring semesters for full-time students in good standing. Matching funds are not available for the summer term.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

All Truett students may apply for federal financial assistance, which is comprised primarily of student loans. In order to be considered for federal aid, please complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

All federal aid applicants are encouraged to file the FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1, 2017, using the 2016 income information. Completing your financial aid file and the admission process by March 1 will enable Baylor University to notify you of your financial aid eligibility before your fall bill is due.

You can complete the FAFSA online at fafsa.gov. Complete the FAFSA using the information from your actual tax return from the 2016 year. Baylor's school code is **003545**.
